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# Gustave Courbet (1819-1877)

Gustave Courbet, French artist and founder of the realist movement in nineteenth-century French painting, is known for his unrealized depictions of peasants. A popular artist of his time, Courbet often created controversy, pushing the boundaries of propriety through implicit sensuality.

Today, *The Origin of the World* (1866), his most famous and explicit work, shows the abdomen and genitals of a woman lying in an unmade bed.

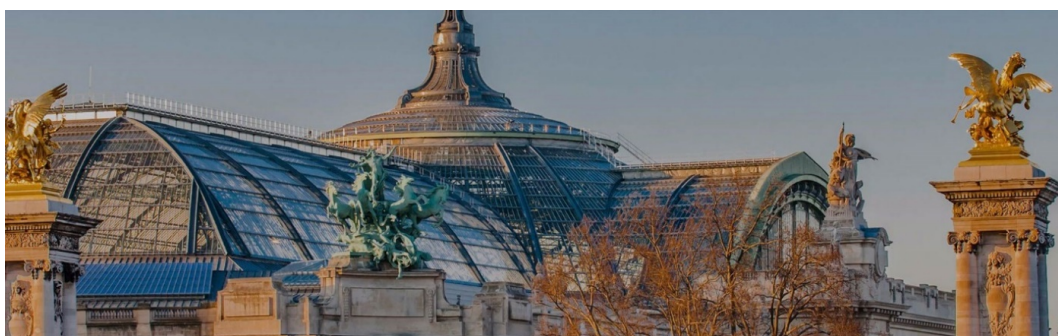
